IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD
NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

1 AN ACT to Prohibit Motor Vehicles over 1,000
2 Pounds on Lakes, Ponds or Reservoirs
3 used to Supply Drinking Water.
4

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
6 follows:

7 29 MRSA §1000 is enacted to read:

8 §1000. Operation of motor vehicles on ice-bound wa-
9 ters

10 No person may operate any motor vehicle with a
11 gross weight in excess of 1,000 pounds on the ice of
12 any reservoir or natural body of water within the
13 State which is used to supply drinking water for any
14 municipality, water district or water association.

1 A violation of this section is a civil violation
2 for which a forfeiture of not more than \$100 may be
3 adjudged for each violation.

4 STATEMENT OF FACT

5 The purpose of this bill is to prohibit vehicles
6 of more than 1,000 pounds on frozen lakes, ponds or
7 reservoirs used to supply drinking water.
