19	A Judge or an Active Retired Judge of the Admin-
20	istrative Court may be assigned by the Chief Justice
21	of the Supreme Judicial Court to sit in the District
22	Court in any district and when so directed he shall
23	have authority and jurisdiction therein as if he were
24	a regular Judge of the District Court; and whenever
25	the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court so
26	directs, he may hear all matters and issue all or-
27	ders, notices, decrees and judgments that any Judge
28	of the District Court is authorized to hear and is-
29	sue.
30	The order of the Chief Justice of the Supreme Ju-
31	dicial Court directing a Judge or an Active Retired
32	Judge of the Administrative Court to sit in the Dis-
33	trict Court shall be filed with the Executive Clerk
34	of the Supreme Judicial Court, but need not be dock-
35	eted or otherwise recorded in any case heard by him.'
