STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Make Allocations for the Administrative Expenses of the Bureau of Lottery, Department of Finance, for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1988, and June 30, 1989.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

10 Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate un-11 til after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

12 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses inci-13 dent to the operation of the Bureau of Lottery will

1 become due and payable on or immediately after July 2 1, 1987; and

3 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 4 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 5 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 6 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-7 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 8 therefore,

9 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 10 follows:

11 Sec. 1. Allocation of fund. In order to provide 12 for the necessary expenses of operation and adminis-13 tration of the Bureau of Lottery, the following 14 amounts, or as much as may be necessary, are allo-15 cated from the revenues derived from operations of 16 the fund.

25 Sec. 2. Allotments required. Upon receipt of al-26 lotments duly approved by the Governor, based upon 27 work programs submitted to the State Budget Officer, 28 the State Controller shall authorize expenditures 29 from these allocations on the basis of these allot-30 ments and not otherwise.

31 Sec. 3. Legislative intent. It is the intent of 32 the Legislature that the allocation of funds by the 33 Legislature, as provided by this Act, shall apply to 34 the administrative expenses only and that these allo-35 cations shall be allotted and approved under the 36 Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5.

Sec. 4. Adjustments to allocations. Allocations may be increased or adjusted by the State Budget Officer with the approval of the Governor, to specifi-cally cover those adjustments determined to be necessary under any salary plan approved by the Legislature and those reclassifications or range changes which have been approved by the Department of Administration and submitted for legislative review prior to the effective date of this Act. 9.

10 Sec. 5. Exclusion. Exclusive of sections 1 to 4, 11 up to \$70,000 each fiscal year may be expended for 12 Capital Expenditures.

13 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited 14 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect on July 15 1, 1987.
