1 AN ACT to Require Affirmative Permission for
2 ATV Use.

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 12 MRSA §7856, sub-§3 is enacted to read:

7 3. Affirmative permission required. A person
8 may not operate an ATV on any land of another without
9 first obtaining affirmative permission from the owner
10 or lessor of that land. Any person who violates this
11 subsection commits a Class E crime. This subsection
12 does not apply if the land is owned or leased by the
13 operator's parent or guardian.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require the affirmative permission of a landowner in order to operate an ATV on that person's land. Failure to obtain that permission will be a Class E crime.
