1 AN ACT to Allow for the Disposal of Blank
2 Election Material within 60 Days of
3 the Election.

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
6 follows:

7 Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §23, sub-§7, as amended by PL
8 1985, c. 383, §1, is further amended to read:

9 7. Ballots and other election materials. The
10 clerk shall keep the ballots and other election mate-
11 rials listed in section 698 in his office for 22
12 months and incoming voting lists for 2 years, unless
13 sooner released to the Secretary of State or required
14 by the Secretary of State to be kept longer; except
15 that the clerk may dispose of the unused ballots and
16 unused absentee ballots, which are on clearly marked
