1 2 3	AN ACT Concerning the Attachment of Real Property and Personal Property.
4 5	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
6 7 8	14 MRSA §4601, as amended by PL 1981, c. 279, §6, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:
9 10 11 12 13 14 15 16	An attachment of personal property shall expire at the end of 5 years from the date of filing the attachment in the office where filed unless the office within that period, at the request of the plaintiff or his attorney, brings forward the attachment and at the expiration of 5 years from the time of the first or any subsequent bringing forward, the attachment shall expire, unless within that period it is again brought forward.

2 This bill nullifies all attachments of personal 3 property after 5 years, the same as in the case of 4 real property.

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
