1 AN ACT to Make Allocations from the Public
2 Utilities Commission Regulatory Fund
3 and the Public Utilities Reimbursement
4 Fund for the Fiscal Year Ending June
5 30, 1988, and June 30, 1989.

7 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
8 lature do not become effective until 90 days after
9 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

10 Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate un-
11 til after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

12 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses inci-
13 dent to the operation of the department will become
14 due and payable on or immediately after July 1, 1987;
15 and

1 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
2 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
3 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
4 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
5 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
6 therefore,

7 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
8 follows:

9 Sec. 1. Allocation of Public Utilities Commis-
10 sion Regulatory Fund and the Public Utilities Commis-
11 sion Reimbursement Fund. Income to the Public Utili-
12 ties Commission Regulatory Fund and the Public Utili-
13 ties Commission Reimbursement Fund for the next 2
14 fiscal years, from July 1, 1987, to June 30, 1988,
15 and from July 1, 1988, to June 30, 1989, shall be
16 segregated, apportioned and disbursed as designated
17 in the following schedule.

9 Sec. 2. Adjustments to allocations. Allocations
10 may be increased or adjusted by the State Budget Of-
11 ficer with the approval of the Governor, to specifi-
12 cally cover those adjustments determined to be neces-
13 sary under any salary plan approved by the Legisla-
14 ture, and those reclassifications or range changes
15 which have been approved by the Department of Admin-
16 istration and submitted for legislative review prior
17 to the effective date of this Act.

18 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited
19 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect on July
20 1, 1987.
