IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Amend the Marriage Prohibitions Based on Consanguinity.

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 5 follows:

6 19 MRSA §31, as amended by PL 1985, c. 181, is 7 further amended to read:

8 §31. Marriages prohibited within certain degrees

9 No man may marry his mother, grandmother, daugh-10 ter, grandaughter, sister, brother's daughter, 11 sister's daughter, father's sister, mother's sister, 12 the daughter of his father's brother or sister or the 13 daughter of his mother's brother or sister. No woman 14 may marry her father, grandfather, son, grandson,

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brother, brother's son, sister's son, father's broth-1 er, mother's brother, the son of her father's brother or sister or the son of her mother's brother or sis-2 3 4 ter. A man may marry the daughter of his father's brother or sister or the daughter of his mother's 5 6 brother or sister, and a woman may marry the son of her father's brother or sister or the son of her 7 mother's brother or sister, if, after notice and 8 9 hearing, a Probate Court or District Court finds that it is medically certain that no children could be 10 11 born of that marriage.

STATEMENT OF FACT

13 This bill amends the recently enacted prohibition 14 on marriage between cousins, to allow such a marriage 15 when children could not be born of the couple.

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
