HOUSE AMENDMENT "^A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to
H.P. 412, L.D. 546, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the
Charter of the Lubec Port Authority."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the
emergency preamble (page 1, lines 16 to 30 in amend-
ment).

Further amend the amendment in section 2 by in-
serting after the 2nd paragraph the following:

'If any person or corporation sustains damages by
any taking and does not agree with the authority on
the sum to be paid therefor, either party, upon peti-
tion to the county commissioners of Washington Coun-
ty, may have those damages assessed by them; and the
procedure and right of appeal shall be the same as
are prescribed in the case of damages by the laying
out of town ways.'

Further amend the amendment in section 6 in the
first line (page 8, line 3 in amendment) by striking
out the following: "~~Emergency clause; referendum;~~"
and inserting in its place the following:
'Referendum;'

Further amend the amendment in section 6 by
striking out all of the first sentence (page 8, lines
4 to 9 in amendment) and inserting in its place the
following: 'This Act shall not take effect unless it
is submitted to and accepted by the legal voters of
the Town of Lubec, voting at a regular or special
election called and held for the purpose within 24
months after the approval of this Act.'

Further amend the amendment in section 6 in the
3rd paragraph by striking out all of the first sen-

1 tence (page 8, lines 27 to 33 in amendment) and in-
2 sserting in its place the following: 'This Act shall
3 be accepted by an affirmative vote by a majority of
4 the legal voters voting at the election; provided
5 that the total number of votes cast for and against
6 the acceptance of this Act at the meeting equaled or
7 exceeded 10% of the total number of votes cast for
8 Governor in the town at the last gubernatorial elec-
9 tion.'

10 Further amend the amendment in section 6 in the
11 last paragraph by striking out all of the first sen-
12 tence (page 8, line 37 and page 9, lines 1 and 2 in
13 amendment)
