8 9 0 1 2 3	With the consent of a majority of the selectmen, the authority may take or acquire within the limits of the Town of Lubec real property, by purchase or otherwise, by gift or grant or by the exercise of the right of eminent domain pursuant to section 2, which right is expressly delegated to the Lubec Port Authority, and hold the real property and rights and
5 6	easements therein as the directors may from time to

2	docks and warehouses, highways and other port facili-
3	ties and shall further have the right to construct

The purpose of this bill is to amend the Private and Special Law authorizing the establishment of the Lubec Port Authority. The bill removes the power of eminent domain from the port authority board of directors.
