STATE OF MAINE IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN AN ACT to Require Notice of Possible Radon Exposure. Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine follows: §4641-E, as amended by PL 1977, c. 679, §32, is further amended by adding at the end 2 paragraphs to read: The State Tax Assessor shall cause the following notice to be affixed to any form issued by the Bureau of Taxation and filed with the county registry of deeds for the purpose of collecting the real estate transfer tax under this chapter:

STATEMENT OF FACT

12 The purpose of this bill is to ensure that home 13 buyers are notified of the potential health 14 posed by naturally occurring radon gas. Radon gas is prevalent in many areas of the State. The notice al-15 16 so provides information on the testing services 17 available at the state Public Health Laboratory in 18 Augusta. The bill also provides penalties for any 19 home seller or his real estate agent who fails to 20 show the notice to the home buyer.
