Amend the bill in section 5 in that part designated "\$1528." by adding at the end the following: '3. Local participation in siting decision. Within 60 days of the final selection by the authority of the low-level waste disposal facility site, the governing body of the municipality where the facility is to be located, or the Secretary of State in the case of an unorganized township, shall hold an election for the purpose of approving the site. Unless 60% of the voters casting ballots in the election approve of the authority's site location decision, the authority shall not locate the facility within the manicipality or territory. STATEMENT OF FACT This amendment mandates a local vote of approval before a low-level waste disposal facility may be built in a municipality or township.	1	L.D. 561
