4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 12 MRSA §7457, sub-§1, ¶I is enacted to read:

7 I. Notwithstanding paragraph H, any system regu-
8 lating the taking of antlerless deer may not pro-
9 hibit or require special permit for the taking of
10 antlerless deer by any resident 10 years of age
11 or older and under 16 years of age or any resi-
12 dent 65 years of age or older.
