STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill allows licensed, resident trappers to carry a concealed 22-caliber handgun while actively trapping. Trappers are now advised to purchase a concealed weapons permit for the trapping season because they may carry weapons inside their clothing to protect the weapon against the weather. This does not authorize carrying the weapon during the trapping season while the licensee is not actually trapping.

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
