STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Permit the Use of Speed Bumps.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

29 MRSA §1256, first ¶ is amended to read:

6 Municipalities shall have no power to alter any 7 speed limitations or to enact or enforce any regula-8 tions contrary to this Title; except that they may by 9 ordinances or bylaws regulate traffic by means of 10 signal devices, speed bumps or other appropriate 11 any portion of the way where traffic is methods on 12 heavy or continuous, and prohibit other than one-way 13 traffic upon certain ways, subject to Title 23, sec-14 tion 1351. The speed of vehicles in public parks may 15 be regulated in like manner provided there shall be erected at all entrances to such parks adequate signs 16

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 giving notice of any such special speed regulations.
STATEMENT OF FACT
The purpose of this bill is to allow municipalities to regulate the speed of traffic by means of speed bumps.

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
