COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 433, L.D. 579,
Bill, "AN ACT to Facilitate Mutual Aid Agreements Be-
tween Municipal Police Departments."

Amend the Bill in section 2 in that part desig-
nated "§2366." in the first paragraph in the 2nd line
(page 2, line 11 in L.D.) by striking out the under-
lined word "ordinance" and inserting in its place
the following: 'ordinance'

Further amend the Bill in section 2 in that part
designated "§2366." by inserting after the first par-
agraph the following new paragraph:

'The authorizations of the municipal officers
shall be accompanied by an agreement between the re-
questing municipality and the responding municipality
that specifies which municipality shall be liable, if
any liability is determined to exist, for personal
injury or property damage caused by or occurring to
the police officers of the responding municipality in
the course of assisting the requesting municipality.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to require mu-
nicipalities to agree upon which municipality will
assume liability for a police officer from one munic-
ipality rendering assistance in another before that
assistance is authorized.
