18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25	'The authorizations of the municipal officers shall be accompanied by an agreement between the requesting municipality and the responding municipality that specifies which municipality shall be liable, if any liability is determined to exist, for personal injury or property damage caused by or occurring to the police officers of the responding municipality in the course of assisting the requesting municipality.'

27 28 29 30	The purpose of this amendment is to require municipalities to agree upon which municipality will assume liability for a police officer from one municipality rendering assistance in another before that assistance is authorized.
