6 Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §396-E, sub-§1, ¶A, as enacted
7 by PL 1983, c. 579, §10, is amended to read:

8 A. Except as provided in paragraphs E and D par-
9 agraph C, restricted and unrestricted gifts,
10 grants, devises or income from investment thereof
11 shall not be considered available resources.

12 Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §396-E, sub-§1, ¶D, as amended
13 by PL 1985, c. 339, §3, is repealed.
