8 9 10 11	A. Except as provided in paragraphs & and B paragraph C, restricted and unrestricted gifts, grants, devises or income from investment thereof shall not be considered available resources.
12 13	Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §396-E, sub-§1, ¶D, as amended by PL 1985, c. 339, §3, is repealed.

The purpose of this bill is to remove donor restricted gifts from consideration as a hospital's available financial resources as nonrestricted gifts are not considered to be such resources.
