15	which were issued in the same year as the antique mo-
16	tor vehicle was manufactured, provided that the date
17	of manufacture was 1942 or earlier and the motor ve-
18 19	hicle is registered as an antique motor vehicle under
20	this section. Any antique motor vehicle bearing registration plates with the year of manufacture must
21	also carry, within it, a valid antique motor vehicle
22	registration certificate and the antique motor vehi-
23	cle registration plates matching the certificate.
24 25	The registration plates from 1942 or earlier must have matching plate numbers, must be affixed to both
26	the front and rear of the antique motor vehicle and
27	must conspicuously bear the year of manufacture.'
28	STATEMENT OF FACT
29	This amendment specifies a date of 1942 or ear-
30	lier for antique motor vehicles which are eligible to
31 32	display registration plates bearing the year of the motor vehicle's manufacture.
