AN ACT to Amend the Registration Laws
Concerning Antique Motor Vehicles.

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 29 MRSA §114, 2nd ¶, as amended by PL 1979, c.
7 607, §2, is further amended to read:

8 The Secretary of State is authorized to design
9 and issue registration plates for antique autos,
10 horseless carriages and street rods. These plates
11 shall bear the inscriptions "Antique Auto,"
12 "Horseless Carriage" or "Street Rod" and "Maine."
13 Present owners of antique motor vehicles shall be
14 permitted to keep their existing registration plate
15 numbers for the new registration plates issued under
16 this section. The Secretary of State shall allow the

1 owner of an antique motor vehicle to use a registra-
2 tion plate which was issued in the same year as the
3 car was manufactured, provided that the plate con-
4 spicuously bears on it that year. The fee for regis-
5 tration of an antique auto or horseless carriage
6 shall be \$10. The fee for registration of a street
7 rod shall be \$25.

8 STATEMENT OF FACT

9 This bill allows the owners of antique motor ve-
10 hicles to use registration plates from the same year
11 as the make of the car.
