1 AN ACT to Include the Tacoma Lakes in the
2 Valuation of the Cobbossee Watershed
3 District.

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
6 follows:

7 P&SL 1971, c. 95, §13, 8th sentence, as enacted
8 by P&SL 1973, c. 189, §3, is amended to read:

9 For the purposes of this section, the major lakes,
10 ponds and waterways of the watershed shall be consid-
11 ered to be Torsey Pond, Lake Annabessacook, Lake
12 Maranacook, Lake Cobbosseecontee, Pleasant Pond, Ber-
13 rry Pond, Dexter Pond, Cochnewagon Pond, Narrows
14 Ponds, Little Cobbossee Pond, Wilson Pond, Woodbury
15 Pond, Sand Pond, Buker Pond, Jimmy Pond and

1 Cobbosseecontee Stream down to 100 feet below the New
2 Mills Dam, so called.

3 STATEMENT OF FACT

4 This bill adds the Tacoma Lakes in the Town of
5 Litchfield to the list of designated waterways on
6 which the Cobbossee Watershed District bases its mu-
7 nicipal assessments. This bill does not obligate the
8 Town of Litchfield to join the district

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
