## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Include the Tacoma Lakes in the
Valuation of the Cobbossee Watershed
District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

P&SL 1971, c. 95, §13, 8th sentence, as enacted by P&SL 1973, c. 189, §3, is amended to read:

For the purposes of this section, the major lakes, ponds and waterways of the watershed shall be considered to be Torsey Pond, Lake Annabessacook, Lake Maranacook, Lake Cobbosseecontee, Pleasant Pond, Berry Pond, Dexter Pond, Cochnewagon Pond, Narrows Ponds, Little Cobbossee Pond, Wilson Pond, Woodbury Pond, Sand Pond, Buker Pond, Jimmy Pond and
