AN ACT to Amend the ATV Laws.

3 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
4 follows:

5 12 MRSA §7857, sub-§13 as amended by PL 1985, c.
6 762, §12, is further amended to read:

7 13. Unlawfully operating an ATV while under age.
8 A person is guilty of unlawfully operating an ATV
9 while under age, if he is under the age of ~~15~~ 13
10 years and operates an ATV across any public way main-
11 tained for travel or if he operates an ATV while un-
12 accompanied by an adult, except as provided in sub-
13 section 24, paragraph E.

14 Notwithstanding this subsection, persons over the age
15 of 12 years, who have successfully completed a train-

1 ing course approved by the department pursuant to
2 section 7853, may cross public ways as permitted un-
3 der subsection 24, paragraph D, subparagraph (1).

4 STATEMENT OF FACT

5 The purpose of this bill is to reduce the age at
6 which juveniles may operate ATVS with an accompanying
7 adult from 15 years of age to 13 years of age.
