24	This amendment extends the rights of state em-
25	ployees to employees of the Maine Vocational-Tech-
26 27	nical Institute System for roughly an additional 15 months. Current law provides that employees of the
28	vocational-technical institute system retain the
9	rights and privileges of state employees for a period
30	of 2 years from the date of the establishment of the
11 12	vocational-technical institute system, April 16, 1986. This amendment extends these privileges to Ju-
3	ly 1, 1989.
