1 AN ACT to Exempt Alcohol and Drug Programs

6 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§56 is enacted to read:

7 56. Nonprofit educational foundation. Nonprofit
8 educational foundations which provide programs during
9 the summer teaching young people how to make respon-
10 sible decisions about drugs, alcohol, interpersonal
11 relationships and the environment in a camp setting.
