1 2 3 4	AN ACT to Require that Casualty Insurance Companies Offer Insurance for Unusual Risks.
5 6	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
7	24-A MRSA §2162-B is enacted to read:
8 9	§2162-B. Insurance discrimination based on type of risk
10	No insurer authorized to sell casualty insurance
10 11	in this State may refuse to insure or continue to in-
12	sure any person solely because the person is a type
13	of risk which is different from other risks assumed
14	by the insurer.

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## STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to prevent insurers who sell casualty insurance from denying coverage to people or businesses only for the reason that the risk is different from other risks assumed by the insurer. Some unusual risks, such as water slides, are experiencing difficulties in obtaining casualty insurance.

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
