"Resolve, to Establish a New Commission on Maine's
Future."

Amend the resolve by striking out all of the 3rd
paragraph after the title and inserting in its place
the following:

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'The Governor shall appoint the chairman of the
commission from the membership and the chairman shall
serve at the Governor's pleasure. The commission
members shall serve terms to expire on July 1, 1989,
to enable the commission to advise the Legislature
with respect to the proposals and to follow the im-
plementation of the proposals of the commission. Any
vacancy in membership on the commission shall be
filled by the appointing authority authorized to ap-
point the member whose position has become vacant;
and be it further'

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Further amend the resolve in the 4th paragraph
after the title by striking out all of subsections 5
and 6 and inserting in their place the following:

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'5. A progress report on commission activities
to be submitted to the Governor and the Joint Stand-
ing Committee on State and Local Government not later
than April 1, 1988; and

6. A formal final report on commission activi-
ties to be submitted to the Governor and to the joint
standing committee of the Legislature having juris-
diction over state and local government not later
than January 1, 1989. The final report shall contain
any necessary implementing legislation.'

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Further amend the resolve by adding before the

1 next to the last paragraph before the statement of
2 fact the following:

3 'Staff to the commission. Resolved: That the
4 State Planning Office shall staff the commission to
5 conduct research and prepare reports for the commis-

8 before the statement of fact in the last line (page
9 3, line 36 in L.D.) by striking out the following:
10 "resolve." and inserting in its place the following:
11 'resolve; and be it further'

12 Further amend the resolve by adding before the
13 statement of fact the following:

14 'Appropriation. Resolved: That the following
15 funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry
16 out the purposes of this resolve.
