AN ACT to Promote Adult Education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §8608, as amended by PL 1983, c. 806, §71, is further amended to read:

§8608. Teacher education and administration

The commissioner shall add to the commissioner's budget request a sum not to exceed 5% of the sum recommended for reimbursement to school administrative units for preservice and in-service education activities for teachers in adult education and 5% for the purpose of administering the activities in this chapter.
