1 AN ACT to Require Retail Sellers of Gasoline
2 to Post both Full-service and
3 Self-service Prices.

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
6 follows:

7 10 MRSA §1661 is repealed and the following en-
8 acted in its place:

9 §1661. Posting of prices of internal combustion en-
10 gine fuel

11 1. Fuel for all uses. A retail seller of inter-
12 nal combustion engine fuel, who posts the price
13 charged for fuel, shall include all taxes in the
14 posted price. All posted numerals shall be the same
15 size. For purposes of this section, a numeral is a

1 figure representing a whole number, decimal or frac-
2 tion.

3 2. Fuel for use by vehicles on public highways.
4 Subject to Title 23, chapter 21, a retail seller of
5 internal combustion engine fuel to be used by vehi-
6 cles on public highways shall post the price charged
7 for each fuel grade including the price for self-
8 service and full-service, if those services are
9 available. Prices shall be posted in a manner that
10 is clearly visible to the traveling public.

11 STATEMENT OF FACT

12 This bill requires that prices for full-service
13 and self-service of all grades of gasoline be posted.
