Resolve, Authorizing Sharon Trafton Duthie to Bring Suit Against the State of Maine.

Sharon Trafton Duthie; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$786.58 to be paid to Sharon Trafton Duthie of Charleston as a full and final settlement of her claim against the State for damage to her car by an escapee from the Charleston Correctional Center.

On or about September 6, 1986, the motor vehicle belonging to Sharon Trafton Duthie of Charleston was stolen by an escapee of the Charleston Correctional Center and, while the Maine State Police were in pursuit, the vehicle was damaged in a road block to the extent of \$786.58. The agencies involved have denied voluntary payment of this claim.

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
