20 STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill removes provisions which set maximum rates for workers' compensation and returns the entire rate-making process to the Superintendent of Insurance. The standards which the superintendent must use in approving or disapproving rates remain in the law.

This bill also removes the requirement that the superintendent report to the Legislature by May 1, 1987, regarding savings realized by other amendments which related to the purpose of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 24-A, section 2355.

References to Title 24-A, section 2355, are removed from Title 24-A, section 2357, in section 2 of the bill.

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
