AN ACT Relating to Nonresident Property

2 3 4	Owners for the Purpose of Licensure Under the Fisheries and Wildlife Laws.
5 6	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
<b>7</b> 8	12 MRSA $\S7001$ , sub- $\S32$ , as amended by PL 1983, c. 797, $\S1$ , is further amended to read:
9	32. Resident. "Resident" means a citizen of the
.0	United States who has been domiciled in this State
.1	continuously during the 3 months next prior to the
.2	date on which he applies for any license or permit
.3	under chapter 707, or an alien who has been so domi-
.4	ciled for one year or a citizen who can show proof of
.5	ownership of real property in this State. No person
6	may be considered a resident if he has not.

1	A. If registered to vote, registered in Maine;
2 3 4	B. If licensed to drive a motor vehicle, made application for a Maine motor vehicle operator's license;
5 6 7	C. If owning a motor vehicle or vehicles located within the State, registered each such vehicle in Maine; and
8	D. Complied with the state income tax laws.
9 10 11 12 13	A person who is a full-time student at a Maine college or university, who has resided in Maine continuously for 3 months and has satisfied the requirements of paragraphs A to D shall be rebuttably presumed to have been domiciled in Maine during that period.
14	STATEMENT OF FACT
15 16 17	For the purpose of fisheries and wildlife licenses, a person who can show ownership of real property in the State shall be considered a resident.
