COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 485, L.D. 652,
Bill, "AN ACT to Provide State Reimbursement to Mu-
nicipalities for Property Tax Losses Due to State-
owned Property."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after
the enacting clause and before the statement of fact
and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 34-A MRSA §1402, sub-§7 is enacted to
read:

7. Payments to municipalities. In order to pro-
vide partial reimbursement to municipalities for
property tax losses resulting from new state correc-
tional facilities, the commissioner shall negotiate
fees for service agreements with municipalities and
other governmental units requesting financial support
for services rendered to state correctional facili-
ties constructed after October 1, 1987.

Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall take ef-
fect July 1, 1989.

FISCAL NOTE

This bill will have a future cost which is poten-
tially significant and depends upon the nature of the
agreements entered into between the commissioner and
municipalities.'
