9 10 11 12 13 14	On or before September 1st of the even-numbered years, all departments and other agencies of the State Government and corporations and, associations and community agencies with state contracts receiving or desiring to receive state funds under the provisions of law shall prepare, in the manner prescribed by and on blanks furnished them by the State Budget					

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Officer, and submit to said officer estimates of their expenditure and appropriation requirements for fiscal year of the ensuing biennium contrasted with the corresponding figures of the last completed fiscal year and the estimated figures for the current fiscal year. The expenditure estimates shall be clas-sified to set forth the data by funds, organization units, character and objects of expenditure. The ganization units may be sub-elassified subclassified by functions and activities, or in any other manner, at the discretion of the State Budget Officer. Budget instructions to all departments and agencies shall require them to seek estimates of expenditure and ap-propriation requirements of community-based agencies with whom the department or agency has contracted for services. These estimates may be provided by any appropriate state association in place of an individual community-based agency.

Tentative revenue estimates prepared by the State Budget Officer during the month of September of the even-numbered years shall be revised by this officer during the following November for inclusion in the budget. The revenue estimates shall be classified so as to show the income by organization units, sources and funds, or in any other manner, at the discretion of the State Budget Officer.

Upon receipt of the budget estimates submitted in accordance with this section, the State Budget Officer may require the heads of departments and other agencies of the State Government and officers of organizations and associations receiving or desiring to receive state funds under the provisions of law to appear before said officer and present such additional data in support of their budget estimates as said officer may deem necessary.

Community agency estimates prepared in accordance with this section shall be included in department and agency requests submitted to the Governor. Community agency estimates shall be separately identified within each budget line item prepared by departments and agencies. Budget documents submitted to the Governor or Governor-elect to the Legislature shall separately identify community agency requests, estimates and almosations proposed.
