## 1 STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment reduces the authorized position count from 20 to 10 with a corresponding decrease in the personal services allocation. The amendment sets a ceiling on capital expenditures, other than duly authorized lease-purchase agreements of \$750,000 annually. The amendment also transfers the management of state telecommunications services within the Department of Administration from the Bureau of Public Improvements to the Office of Information Services.
