1                      AN ACT to Make Allocations for the Operating  
2                                      Expenditures of the Intergovernmental

8                      Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-  
9                                      lature do not become effective until 90 days after  
10                                      adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

11                      Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate un-  
12                                      til after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

13                      Whereas, certain obligations and expenses will  
14                                      become due and payable on or immediately after July  
15                                      1, 1987; and

1           Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,  
2 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of  
3 the Constitution of Maine and require the following  
4 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-  
5 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,  
6 therefore,

7 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
8 follows:

9           Sec. 1. Allocation of fund. In order to provide  
10 for the necessary expenses of operation and adminis-  
11 tration of the Intergovernmental Telecommunications  
12 Fund of the Department of Administration, the follow-  
13 ing amounts, or as much as may be necessary, are al-  
14 located from the revenues derived from operations of  
15 the fund.

25           Sec. 2. Adjustments to allocations. Allocations  
26 may be increased or adjusted by the State Budget Of-  
27 ficer with the approval of the Governor to specifi-  
28 cally cover those adjustments determined to be neces-  
29 sary under any salary plan approved by the Legisla-  
30 ture, and those reclassifications and range changes  
31 which have been approved by the Department of Admin-  
32 istration and submitted for legislative review prior  
33 to the effective date of this Act.

34           Sec. 3. Exclusion. Exclusive of the provisions  
35 of sections 1 and 2, such amounts as are determined  
36 necessary, by the Commissioner of Administration, to  
37 meet the statutory responsibilities of this program,

1 as defined by the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5,  
2 section 1742, may be used for those Capital Expendi-  
3 tures which are directly related to the provision or  
4 maintenance of appropriate levels of overall service  
5 capability, but not otherwise. It is the intent of  
6 the Legislature that no capital items purchased under  
7 this section may be given, transferred, sold or oth-  
8 erwise conveyed to any other department, agency or  
9 account, unless the transaction has received specific  
10 prior legislative authorization through the budgetary  
11 process.

12 Sec. 4. Encumbered balance at year end. At the  
13 end of each fiscal year, all encumbered balances  
14 shall not be carried more than once.

15 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited  
16 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-  
17 proved.
