1 AN ACT to Amend the Laws Relating to
2 Cosmetology License Requirements.
3

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §1652, sub-§2, as repealed and
7 replaced by PL 1977, c. 398, §10, is amended to read:

8 2. Education. Who has completed the ~~10th~~ 12th
9 grade in a secondary school or its equivalent;

10 Sec. 2. 32 MRSA §1652, sub-§3, as amended by PL
11 1983, c. 841, §21, is further amended to read:

12 3. Training. Who has satisfactorily completed a
13 course of instruction of 1,500 hours in not less than
14 9 months in a school of cosmetology licensed by the

1 Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services, or
2 in lieu thereof has had a total experience in the
3 practice of cosmetology or as an apprentice of 2,500
4 hours distributed over a period of at least 18
5 months; and

6 Sec. 3. 32 MRSAs §1652, sub-§4, as repealed and
7 replaced by PL 1977, c. 398, §10, is amended to read:

8 4. Examination. Who has satisfactorily passed an
9 examination conducted by the board to determine his
10 fitness to receive such certificate; and

11 Sec. 4. 32 MRSAs §1652, sub-§5 is enacted to
12 read:

13 5. Apprenticeship. Who has completed 500 hours
14 of apprenticeship, after examination, under the di-
15 rection of a registered cosmetologist.

16 Sec. 5. 32 MRSAs §1657, 2nd ¶, as repealed and
17 replaced by PL 1977, c. 398, §10, is amended to read:

18 The certificate of registration shall be renewed
19 on or before the first day of July biennially. A cer-
20 tificate of registration may be renewed only if the
21 holder provides such evidence as the board requires
22 of at least 6 hours of participation annually in edu-
23 cational shows. The holder of the certificate of reg-
24 istration shall pay the board for the biennial renew-
25 al a sum between \$20 and \$35, as determined by the
26 board.

27 STATEMENT OF FACT

28 The purpose of this bill is to increase the re-
29 quirements for registration and renewal certificates
30 for cosmetologists.
