NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Exempt Certain Signs from the  
Billboard Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
follows:

Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §1913-A, sub-§2, ¶¶D and E, as  
enacted by PL 1981, c. 318, §3, are amended to read:

D. Signs erected by nonprofit historical and  
cultural institutions. Each institution, which  
has certified its nonprofit status with the com-  
missioner, may erect not more than 2 signs with a  
surface area not to exceed 50 square feet per  
sign; and

E. Signs bearing political messages; and
