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1           Resolve, to Establish a Commission to Study  
2                           United States Route 1.  
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4           Study commission created. Resolved: That there  
5 is created a commission to study United States Route  
6 1; and be it further

7           Appointment. Resolved: That the commission shall  
8 consist of 9 members as follows: One senator, whose  
9 district includes communities traversed by United  
10 States Route 1, appointed by the President of the  
11 Senate; 2 representatives, each of whose districts  
12 include communities traversed by United States Route  
13 1, appointed by the Speaker of the House of Represen-  
14 tatives; the Commissioner of Transportation or his  
15 designee; the Commissioner of Environmental Protec-  
16 tion or his designee; the Director of the State De-  
17 velopment Office or his designee; the Director of the

1 State Planning Office or his designee; and 2 members  
2 representing the public, each of whom resides in a  
3 community traversed by United States Route 1, ap-  
4 pointed by the Governor. The commission shall choose  
5 a chairman from among its members; and be it further

6 Duties. Resolved: That the commission shall un-  
7 dertake to study and write a comprehensive plan for  
8 the proposed rehabilitation, design or redesign, con-  
9 struction or reconstruction of United States Route 1  
10 and its auxiliary highway network from Brunswick in  
11 Cumberland County through Washington County. The  
12 commission shall examine traffic patterns, traffic  
13 safety concerns and alternatives, such as bypasses  
14 around congested areas, and shall consider the promo-  
15 tion of tourism opportunities throughout the State,  
16 economic development, resource utilization and envi-  
17 ronmental protection in the mid-coast and east coast  
18 regions of the State; and be it further

19 Compensation. Resolved: That legislative members  
20 shall receive per diem compensation and all other  
21 members shall be reimbursed for travel and other nec-  
22 essary expenses; and be it further

23 Reports. Resolved: That the commission shall  
24 present its findings together with any recommended  
25 legislation, to the Second Regular Session of the  
26 113th Legislature.

27 STATEMENT OF FACT

28 The resolve establishes the Commission to Study  
29 United States Route 1 from Brunswick through Washing-  
30 ton County.

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
