Resolved: That the commission shall consist of 9 members as follows: One senator, whose district includes communities traversed by United States Route 1, appointed by the President of the Senate; 2 representatives, each of whose districts include communities traversed by United States Route 1, appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives; the Commissioner of Transportation or his designee; the Commissioner of Environmental Protection or his designee; the Director of the State Development Office or his designee; the Director of the

State Planning Office or his designee; and 2 members representing the public, each of whom resides in a community traversed by United States Route 1, appointed by the Governor. The commission shall choose a chairman from among its members; and be it further

6 Duties. Resolved: That the commission shall un-7 dertake to study and write a comprehensive plan for the proposed rehabilitation, design or redesign, con-8 . 9 struction or reconstruction of United States Route 1 10 and its auxiliary highway network from Brunswick in Cumberland County through Washington County. The commission shall examine traffic patterns, traffic 11 12: safety concerns and alternatives, such as bypasses 13 around congested areas, and shall consider the promo-14 tion of tourism opportunities throughout the State, 15 16 economic development, resource utilization and envi-17 ronmental protection in the mid-coast and east coast 18 regions of the State; and be it further

Compensation. Resolved: That legislative members shall receive per diem compensation and all other members shall be reimbursed for travel and other necessary expenses; and be it further

Reports. Resolved: That the commission shall present its findings together with any recommended legislation, to the Second Regular Session of the 113th Legislature.
