### STATEMENT OF FACT

Community nonprofit agencies, providing day pro-grams and work activity services to the State's men-13 14 tally retarded adults, lag far behind in cost-of-living increases from the State. In the last bi-15 16 17 ennium, only one 2% cost-of-living increase was granted and that increase only after an emergency 18 19 funding bill in a legislative special session. This bill, providing funds for a 5% cost-of-living in-20 crease in the next biennium, will keep programs at 21 22 current levels, with no opportunities for increased 23 client needs.
