7	§1635. Use of safety equipment
8 9 0 1 2	No person may prohibit the use of a life jacket or similar device in a swimming pool by any person who suffers, as evidenced by a signed statement of a licensed physician, from any physical disability or condition which necessitates the use of a life jacket or similar device.

2	This bill provides that no one may prohibit any
3	person who has a physical disability from using a
4	life jacket or similar device in a swimming pool,
5	when the person's disability necessitates its use, as
6	evidenced by a signed statement from a physician.
