1 'FISCAL NOTE

2 The bill results in the following effect on reve-
3 nues:

6 STATEMENT OF FACT

7 This amendment corrects an erroneous reference to
8 the Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services
9 and changes the reference to the Executive Director
10 of the Maine Vocational-Technical Institute System.

11 This amendment removes the allocation of special
12 dedicated revenues in the Department of Educational
13 and Cultural Services for the Maine Fire Training and
14 Educational Program. This program will be under the
15 jurisdiction of and administered by the Maine Voc-
16 ational-Technical Institute System with the special
17 dedicated revenues currently derived from the assess-
18 ment on fire insurance policies and premiums.

19 The net effect of the bill is to transfer the
20 Maine Fire Training and Educational Program along
21 with the dedicated revenues that fund it from the De-
22 partment of Educational and Cultural Services to the
23 Maine Vocational-Technical Institute System.
