4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 36 MRSA §6108, 2nd ¶, as enacted by PL 1985, c.
7 421, §2, is amended to read:

8 Beginning March 1, 1986, and annually thereafter,
9 the State Tax Assessor shall determine the household
10 income eligibility adjustment factor. That factor
11 shall be multiplied by the income limitations appli-
12 cable for the year prior to that for which relief is
13 requested. The result shall be rounded to the nearest
14 \$100 and shall apply to the year for which relief is
15 requested corresponding to the year on which the an-
16 nualized cost-of-living adjustments were based. Be-

1 ginning March 1, 1988, the State Tax Assessor shall
2 increase the maximum single member household income
3 requirement by \$2,100 in equal installments over the
4 next 4 years and increase the maximum household in-
5 come requirement for 2 people or more by \$1,500 in
6 equal installments over the next 4 years.

STATEMENT OF FACT

8 The purpose of this bill is to increase the in-
9 come limitation for singles to \$8,300 and \$8,900 for
10 couples.

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
