4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 12 MRSA §7107-A, sub-§5, ¶A, as enacted by PL
7 1985, c. 320, §2, is repealed and the following en-
8 acted in its place:

9 A. Notwithstanding section 7457, subsection 1,
10 paragraph H, it is lawful to kill an antlerless
11 deer during the muzzle-loading hunting season as
12 established in subsection 4.
