4 5	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
6 7 8	12 MRSA \$7107-A, sub-\$5, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 320, \$2, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
9	A. Notwithstanding section 7457, subsection 1,
10	paragraph H, it is lawful to kill an antlerless
11	deer during the muzzle-loading hunting season as
12	established in subsection 4.

This bill allows the taking of deer of either sex under a muzzle-loading hunting license.

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
