The tax relief programs in this bill include phase-in provisions which will increase the number of persons eligible and the amounts that persons eligible will receive. The Elderly Low Cost Drug Program will also increase due to increases in the number eligible.'
12	STATEMENT OF FACT
13 14 15 16 17	This amendment provides a sunset provision to become effective June 30, 1989. The amendment also reduces the appropriation for the Elderly Low Cost Drug Program to \$350,000 in order to reduce the biennial appropriation to \$4,000,000 which is the amount included for this program in the Part II budget.
