SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 542, L.D. 726

1 STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment replaces the new draft to clarify that any prisoner in a state correctional facility or 3 a county jail who is providing services, with or without remuneration, either inside or outside the 4 5 6 facility or jail and under staff supervision, will not be considered an employee for the purposes of workers' compensation. This amendment does not re-7 8 9 move a prisoner from coverage under the Workers' Com-10 pensation Act if he is working at a private through a work-release or similar program. It only 11 applies to labor performed in the or outside of the facility or jail when under staff supervision. 12 13
