STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Eliminate the Statute of Limitation in Child Molestation or Incest Cases.

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 5 follows:

17-A MRSA §8, sub-§2-A is enacted to read:

2-A. Notwithstanding subsection 2, the periods of limitations set out in subsection 2 shall not begin to run for prosecution of any of the following crimes until the victim is 18 years of age:

11 A. Incest under section 556;

12B. Rape under section 252, when the victim is13under the age of 14 at the time of the commission14of the crime;

C. Gross sexual misconduct under section 253, 1 2 when the victim is under the age of 14 at the 3 time of the commission of the crime; 4 Sexual abuse of a minor under section 254, D. when the victim is under the age of 16 5 at the 6 time of the commission of the crime, or when the victim is under the age of 18 at the time of the 7 8 commission of the crime and the defendant is a 9 parent, stepparent, foster parent, guardian or other similar person responsible for the long-10 term general care and welfare of the victim; 11 or 12 Unlawful sexual contact under section 255, Ε. when the victim: 13 14 Is under the age of 14 at the time of (1)15 the commission of the crime and the defend-16 ant is at least 3 years older; or 17 (2) Is under the age of 18 at the time of 18 the commission of the crime and the elements 19 set out in section 255, subsection 1, para-20 graph F are met at the time of the commis-21 sion of the crime. 22

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to postpone the run-23 24 ning of the statute of limitation on the crime of in-25 cest and other sex offenses involving children until the victim is 18 years of age. 26
